Checking-in at Voorhees Dorm

Voorhees is located on the corner of 10th and College.

Plan to arrive at Voorhees Hall at 9:10 a.m. on Wednesday, June 12, 2024

- ◆ Limited parking is available in front of Voorhees on 10th street for drop off and pickup. Longer term parking for registration and graduation is available at the T-lot on 10th street – the lot is west of College and 10th just beyond Pillar Church. A map of Hope College is enclosed.
- ◆ All medications, with the exceptions of inhalers, should be given to the counselor at check-in.
- ◆ There will be two or three students per room. Sheets will be provided. Students should bring their own pillows and pillowcases, toiletries, and towels.
- ◆ If you need to leave a message for your son or daughter: we will provide you at registration a cell phone number where you will be able to reach a counselor day or night throughout the training. Please limit calls on this number to emergencies.
- ◆ For your child's protection the outside dorm doors are always locked. Counselors have cards that can open the doors.
- ◆ While you are at Voorhees Hall, please stop by and meet your child's counselor.
